### Spring Road Conditions

The City of Pembroke wishes to advise pedestrians and motorists to use caution as they travel about the City of Pembroke. There are a number of obstacles that users of the transportation network need to be aware of as follows:

- Winter Control Activities – While snow storms are hopefully over for the remainder of the winter season, snow and freezing rain are still a possibility. Typical winter control activities may continue for weeks to come including sanding, salting and plowing.
- Roadside Snow Melt – As snow that has accumulated at the side of the road melts, it creates large puddles which pose a hazard to both pedestrians and vehicles. The travelling public should also be aware that temperature changes between day and night have the potential of creating localized icy spots and the freeze-thaw cycle leads to the formation of potholes which may be hidden below surface water.
- Heaving – This winter has seen significant frost depths across Eastern Ontario. As the frost leaves the road base, heaving is likely to occur.
- Pot Hole Repair – Crews are working across the City to repair potholes as efficiently as possible.
