Team Rubicon Canada will be in Pembroke on Friday May 24, 2019 with a Rapid Damage Assessment Team who will visit all flood-impacted properties within the city to assess property damage caused by the flood.

Team Rubicon Canada unites skilled military veterans with first responders to serve disaster-affected communities. Team Rubicon Canada's primary mission is to provide disaster response services to those in need. By pairing the skills and experiences of military veterans with first responders, Team Rubicon Canada aims to provide the greatest service and impact possible.

Over the next week, Team Rubicon Canada's Rapid Damage Assessment teams will be working in areas identified by municipal planners as those that have been highly impacted by the recent floods. Homeowners—of both primary and seasonal residences—who have been impacted are encouraged to self-identify through the Request for Assistance form at the link below. After receiving the requests, the information will be cataloged and reviewed to assist with having a more complete understanding of the impacts to help develop the City's strategy for moving forward with recovery.
