BY-LAW NUMBER 2010 - 01


BEING A BY-LAW FOR THE PURPOSE OF REGULATING
THE DISCHARGE OF FIREARMS WITHIN THE
CORPORATION OF THE CITY OF PEMBROKE

WHEREAS Section 119 of the *Municipal Act, 2001*, S.O. 2001, c.25, as amended, provides that a municipality may, for the purpose of public safety, prohibit or regulate the discharge of guns or other firearms, air-guns, spring-guns, cross-bows, long-bows or any other weapon;


NOW THEREFORE THE MUNICIPAL COUNCIL OF THE CORPORATION OF THE CITY OF PEMBROKE ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

1. No person shall discharge, or permit anyone to discharge, any gun or other firearm, air-gun, spring-gun, cross-bow, long-bow or any other weapon within the Corporation of the City of Pembroke, save and except as follows:
 - (a) On land occupied by any authorized firearm club after permission to the said club has been granted by resolution of Council;
 - (b) A special organized firearm activity for which approval has been granted by resolution of Council; or
 - (c) By individuals licensed to trap fur bearing animals within the County of Renfrew under authority of the *Fish and Wildlife Conservation Act, R.S.O. 1997, c.41*, as amended, with permission of the owner or tenant of property or at the request of the Police Service for the sole purpose of the destruction of an animal posing a nuisance or threat to inhabitants or to humanely destroy an animal in distress.
2. Every person who contravenes any provision of this by-law is guilty of an offence and on conviction is liable to a fine as provided for in the *Provincial Offences Act, R.S.O. 1990, cP.33*, as amended.
3. That By-law Number 99-63 be, and it is, hereby repealed in its entirety.
4. This by-law shall come into force and take effect upon the date of the final passing thereof.






