

THE CORPORATION OF THE CITY OF PEMBROKE

BY-LAW NUMBER 2013 – 48

A BY-LAW TO AMEND BY-LAW 2005-55,
AS AMENDED, BEING A BY-LAW TO REGULATE AND CONTROL
THE PARKING OF VEHICLES IN THE CITY OF PEMBROKE

WHEREAS Section 11(1) of the Municipal Act, 2001, S.O. 2001, c. 25 states that a single-tier municipality may pass by-laws respecting highways, including parking and traffic on highways;

AND WHEREAS the Council of the Corporation of the City of Pembroke deems it expedient to amend By-law 2005-55, being a by-law to regulate and control the parking of vehicles;

NOW THEREFORE THE MUNICIPAL COUNCIL OF THE CORPORATION OF THE CITY OF PEMBROKE ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

1. THAT Schedule "C" – NO PARKING ZONES of By-law 2005-55 be amended by adding thereto the following:
 - (i) Laurier Avenue, north side, from a point measured sixteen (16) metres west of the westerly extension of Mackay Street.
 - (ii) Alexander Street, both sides, from Lake Street to Fred Blackstein Boulevard.
2. THAT Schedule "C" – NO PARKING ZONES of By-law 2005-55 be amended by deleting therefrom the following:
 - (i) Alexander Street, west side, southerly from Fred Blackstein Boulevard to Lake Street.
 - (ii) alexander Street, east side, from Lake Street to CPR Trestle.
3. THAT Schedule "I" – NO STOPPING ZONES of By-law 2005-55 be amended by adding thereto the following:
 - (i) Trafalgar Road, east side from a point measured twenty.one (20.1) metres south of the southerly extension of Isabella Street.
4. THAT Part III – Parking- General Regulations of By-law 2005-55 be amended by adding thereto the following:
 - (i) Section 24 – Three Hour Parking
 - (a) Where signs are erected indicating "Three Hour Parking" no person shall park a vehicle for a longer period than designated by such signs as set out in **Schedule "Y"** of this by-law. If the vehicle is removed, it shall not be parked within three hundred (300) metres from the point at which it was first parked within one hour from its time of removal.
5. THAT Schedule "Y" – Three Hour Parking of Parking By-law 2005-55 be amended by adding thereto the following:

Schedule "Y" to By-law 2005-55

Three Hour Parking Zones (Part III, Section 23(a))

Marina Parking Lot from September 1 to May 1.

Cockburn Parking Lot from September 1 to May 1.

6. THAT Schedule "E" – Two Hour Parking Zones of Parking By-law 2005-55 be amended by adding thereto the following:

Waterfront Playground Parking Lot on Fred Blackstein Boulevard from September 1 to May 1.
7. THAT Part V – Parking Lots – Section 2 – Parking Lot Designation and Time Limits of Parking By-law 2005-55 be amended by adding thereto the following:
 - (f) Cockburn Parking Lot

(iii) No person shall park a vehicle, other than a vehicle used for emergency purposes without a valid permit or exceed the permitted time period of three hours in the Cockburn Parking Lot and an vehicle that is so parked may be removed at the owner's expense when such removal is authorized by a Municipal By-law Enforcement Officer.

8. THAT Schedule "L" – Section 2 – Parking Permits – Patterson, City Hall, Pembroke Courthouse, Market Square, Alexander and Barrymore of By-law 2005-55 be amended by adding thereto the following:

Cockburn Parking Lot

3. The provisions of this by-law shall apply to vehicles parked or standing upon the Cockburn Parking Lot.

a. 7:00 a.m. to 10:00 p.m.

Monday, Tuesday, Wednesday, Thursday and Friday

b. Monthly Permit \$ 40.00 + HST

Six Month Permit \$200.00 + HST

One Year Permit \$350.00 + HST

c. Monthly Permit for Students of Algonquin College \$ 40.00 + HST

Semester Permit for Students of Algonquin College \$165.00 + HST

One Year Permit for Students of Algonquin College \$266.00 + HST

9. THAT Schedule "T" – Fines and Penalties, of By-law 2005-55 be amended by adding thereto the following:

Part III, Section 24(a) – Parked contrary to three (3) hour parking limit - \$20.00


10. Every person who contravenes any section of this by-law is guilty of an offence and on conviction is liable to a fine as provided for in the Provincial Offences Act, as amended.

11. This by-law shall come into force and take effect upon the date of the final passing thereof:
