BY-LAW 2014 – 59

A BY-LAW TO AMEND BY-LAW 2005-55,
AS AMENDED, BEING A BY-LAW TO REGULATE AND CONTROL
THE PARKING OF VEHICLES IN THE CITY OF PEMBROKE

WHEREAS Section 11(1) of the Municipal Act, 2001, S.O. 2001, c. 25 states that a single-tier municipality may pass by-laws respecting highways, including parking and traffic on highways;

AND WHEREAS the Council of the Corporation of the City of Pembroke deems it expedient to amend By-law 2005-55, being a by-law to regulate and control the parking of vehicles;


NOW THEREFORE THE MUNICIPAL COUNCIL OF THE CORPORATION OF THE CITY OF PEMBROKE ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

1. THAT Part IV – Meter Parking on Streets - General Regulations of By-law 2005-55 be amended by adding thereto the following:
 - (i) Section 1(c) – Parking Meter Zones
 - (c) The provisions of this by-law with respect to parking meters on streets shall apply as follows to vehicles parked or standing upon public streets where parking meters have been installed:
 - 8:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m.
 - Monday, Tuesday, Wednesday, Thursday, Friday and Saturday
2. THAT Part V – Parking Lots - General Regulations of By-law 2005-55 be amended by deleting therefrom the following:
 - (i) Section 3(o) – Regulations - Metered Parking Lots
 - (o) The provisions of this by-law with respect to parking meters shall apply as follows to vehicles parked or standing upon public parking lots where parking meters have been installed:
 - 9:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m.
 - Monday, Tuesday, Wednesday, Thursday, Friday and Saturday
3. THAT Part V – Parking Lots - General Regulations of By-law 2005-55 be amended by adding thereto the following:
 - (j) Section 3(o) – Regulations - Metered Parking Lots
 - (o) The provisions of this by-law with respect to parking meters shall apply as follows to vehicles parked or standing upon public parking lots where parking meters have been installed:
 - 8:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m.
 - Monday, Tuesday, Wednesday, Thursday, Friday and Saturday
4. Every person who contravenes any section of this by-law is guilty of an offence and on conviction is liable to a fine as provided for in the Provincial Offences Act, as amended.
5. This by-law shall come into force and take effect upon the date of the final passing thereof.


