BY-LAW NUMBER 2015 – 56

A BY-LAW TO AMEND BY-LAW 2005-55, AS AMENDED,  
BEING A BY-LAW TO REGULATE AND CONTROL THE PARKING  
OF VEHICLES IN THE CITY OF PEMBROKE


WHEREAS Section 11(1) of the Municipal Act, 2001, S.O. 2001, c. 25 states that a single-tier municipality may pass by-laws respecting highways, including parking and traffic on highways;


AND WHEREAS the Council of the Corporation of the City of Pembroke deems it expedient to amend By-law 2005-55, being a by-law to regulate and control the parking of vehicles;

NOW THEREFORE THE MUNICIPAL COUNCIL OF THE CORPORATION OF THE CITY OF PEMBROKE ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:


1. THAT Schedule "C" – NO PARKING ZONES of By-law 2005-55 be amended by adding thereto the following:  
James Street, both sides between McGee Street and Mary Street.
2. THAT Schedule "E" – TWO HOUR PARKING ZONES of By-law 2005-55 be amended by adding thereto the following:  
Patterson Parking Lot from May 1<sup>st</sup> to October 31<sup>st</sup>.
3. THAT Part IV - METER PARKING ON STREETS Section 4 – FINES of By-law 2005-55 be amended by adding thereto the following:  
Section 4(e) – Upon the street described in **Schedule "N", Section 5** of this By-law, the deposit shall be twenty-five cent (25) coin for thirty (30) minutes of parking, two twenty-five cent (25) coins for sixty (60) minutes of parking, four twenty-five cent (25) coins or a one dollar (\$1.00) coin for one hundred and twenty (120) minutes, etc. or up to ten twenty-five cent (25) coins or five one dollar (\$1.00) coins for three hundred (300) minutes of parking.
4. THAT Schedule "N" PARKING METER ZONES Section 5 THIRTY MINUTE TO FIVE HOUR LIMIT of By-law 2005-55 be established and by adding thereto the following:  
William Street Disabled Meters only between Pembroke Street East and Nelson Street.
5. Every person who contravenes any section of this by-law is guilty of an offence and on conviction is liable to a fine as provided for in the Provincial Offences Act, as amended.
6. This by-law shall come into force and take effect upon the date of the final passing thereof.
