

THE CORPORATION OF THE CITY OF PEMBROKE

BY-LAW 2016 – 16

A BY-LAW TO AMEND BY-LAW 2005-55,
AS AMENDED, BEING A BY-LAW TO REGULATE AND CONTROL
THE PARKING OF VEHICLES IN THE CITY OF PEMBROKE

WHEREAS Section 11(1) of the Municipal Act, 2001, S.O. 2001, c. 25 states that a single-tier municipality may pass by-laws respecting highways, including parking and traffic on highways;

AND WHEREAS the Council of the Corporation of the City of Pembroke deems it expedient to amend By-law 2005-55, being a by-law to regulate and control the parking of vehicles;

NOW THEREFORE THE MUNICIPAL COUNCIL OF THE CORPORATION OF THE CITY OF PEMBROKE ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

1. THAT Schedule "C" – NO PARKING ZONES of By-law 2005-55 be amended by adding thereto the following:

Margaret Street, west of Moffat Street, from a point measured nineteen point two (19.2) metres from the west street line of Moffat Street to dead end of Margaret Street.

2. THAT Schedule "B" – LOADING ZONES- NO PARKING AREAS of By-law 2005-55 be amended by deleting therefrom the following:

Pembroke Street East, north side, from a point measured fourteen point three three (14.33) metres west from the west street line of Peter Street, west nineteen point eight one (19.81) metres.

3. THAT Schedule "D" – TEN MINUTE PARKING ZONES of By-law 2005-55 be amended by adding thereto the following:

Pembroke Street East, north side, from a point measured from the west street line of Peter Street, west thirty-six point seven seven (36.77 metres).

4. Every person who contravenes any section of this by-law is guilty of an offence and on conviction is liable to a fine as provided for in the Provincial Offences Act, as amended.

5. This by-law shall come into force and take effect upon the date of the final passing thereof.
