BY-LAW 2016 – 21

A BY-LAW TO AMEND BY-LAW 2005-55,  
AS AMENDED, BEING A BY-LAW TO REGULATE AND CONTROL  
THE PARKING OF VEHICLES IN THE CITY OF PEMBROKE

WHEREAS Section 11(1) of the Municipal Act, 2001, S.O. 2001, c. 25 states that a single-tier municipality may pass by-laws respecting highways, including parking and traffic on highways;

AND WHEREAS the Council of the Corporation of the City of Pembroke deems it expedient to amend By-law 2005-55, being a by-law to regulate and control the parking of vehicles;

NOW THEREFORE THE MUNICIPAL COUNCIL OF THE CORPORATION OF THE CITY OF PEMBROKE ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

1. THAT Schedule “C” – NO PARKING ZONES of By-law 2005-55 be amended by adding thereto the following:

Laurier Avenue, north side, from a point measured 123.76 feet from the west of the westerly street line of Mackay Street.

2. THAT Schedule “C” – NO PARKING ZONES of By-law 2005-55 be amended by deleting therefrom the following:

Sussex Street, north side, from Muskrat River to William Street.

3. THAT Schedule “C” – NO PARKING ZONES of By-law 2005-55 be amended by adding thereto the following:

Sussex Street, north side, from Muskrat River to Mackay Street.

4. THAT Schedule “C” – NO PARKING ZONES of By-law 2005-55 be amended by adding thereto the following:

Sussex Street, north side, from John Street to William Street.

5. THAT Schedule “I” – NO STOPPING ZONES of By-law 2005-55 be amended by adding thereto the following:

Mackay Street, west side, between Laurier Avenue and Ellis Avenue.

6. THAT Schedule “J” Section 1 – NO STOPPING ZONES – TIME RESTRICTED of By-law 2005-55 be amended by adding thereto the following:

Laurier Avenue, north side, from a point measured 123.76 feet west from the westerly street line of Mackay Street to a point 423.76 feet from the westerly street line of Mackay Street.

7. THAT Schedule “J” Section 1 – NO STOPPING ZONES – TIME RESTRICTED of By-law 2005-55 be amended by adding thereto the following:

Laurier Avenue, south side, from Mackay Street west to a point 435.55 feet from the westerly street line of Mackay Street.

8. Every person who contravenes any section of this by-law is guilty of an offence and on conviction is liable to a fine as provided for in the Provincial Offences Act, as amended.
9. This by-law shall come into force and take effect upon the date of the final passing thereof.
