

THE CORPORATION OF THE CITY OF PEMBROKE

BY-LAW 2017 – 61

A BY-LAW TO AMEND BY-LAW 2005-55, AS AMENDED, BEING A BY-LAW TO  
REGULATE AND CONTROL THE PARKING OF VEHICLES IN THE CITY OF  
PEMBROKE

---

WHEREAS Section 11(1) of the Municipal Act, 2001, S.O. 2001, c. 25 states that a single-tier municipality may pass by-laws respecting highways, including parking and traffic on highways;

AND WHEREAS the Council of the Corporation of the City of Pembroke deems it expedient to amend By-law 2005-55, being a by-law to regulate and control the parking of vehicles;

NOW THEREFORE THE MUNICIPAL COUNCIL OF THE CORPORATION OF THE CITY OF PEMBROKE ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

1. THAT SCHEDULE “B” – LOADING ZONES – NO PARKING AREAS of By-law 2005-55 be amended by adding thereto the following:

William Street, east side, from a point measured 50 metres north of the northerly street line of Pembroke Street East to a point measured 57 metres north of the northerly street line of Pembroke Street East.

2. THAT SCHEDULE “B” – LOADING ZONES – NO PARKING AREAS of By-law 2005-55 be amended by deleting therefrom the following:

William Street, east side, from Pembroke Street East northerly a distance of eighteen point two (18.2) metres.

3. THAT SCHEDULE “B” – LOADING ZONES – NO PARKING AREAS of By-law 2005-55 be amended by adding thereto the following:

William Street, east side, from a point measured 10 metres north of the northerly street line of Pembroke Street East to a point measured 16.5 metres north of the northerly street line of Pembroke Street East.

4. THAT SCHEDULE “N” – PARKING METER ZONES of By-law 2005-55 be amended by adding thereto the following:

William Street, east side, from Pembroke Street East to Nelson Street.


5. THAT SCHEDULE “O” – DISABLED PARKING of By-law 2005-55 be amended by adding thereto the following:

William Street, east side, measured from a point 38 metres north of the northerly street line of Pembroke Street East to a point measured 47 metres north of the northerly street line of Pembroke Street East.

6. Every person who contravenes any section of this by-law is guilty of an offence and on conviction is liable to a fine as provided for in the Provincial Offences Act, as amended.

7. This by-law shall come into force and take effect upon the date of the final passing thereof.
