

The Corporation of the City of Pembroke

By-law Number 2018-20

A By-law to amend By-law 2005-55, as amended, being a by-law to regulate and control the parking of vehicles in the City of Pembroke.

Whereas Section 11(1) of the Municipal Act, 2001, S.O. 2001, c. 25 states that a single-tier municipality may pass by-laws respecting highways, including parking and traffic on highways;

And Whereas the Council of the Corporation of the City of Pembroke deems it expedient to amend By-law 2005-55, being a by-law to regulate and control the parking of vehicles;

Now Therefore the Municipal Council of the Corporation of the City of Pembroke enacts as follows:

1. That Schedule “B” – LOADING ZONES – NO PARKING AREAS of By-law 2005-55 be amended by deleting therefrom the following:
 - Church Street, east side, from Pembroke Street West southerly a distance of thirty-two point seven one (32.71) metres.
2. That Schedule “B” – LOADING ZONES – NO PARKING AREAS of By-law 2005-55 be amended by adding thereto the following:
 - Moffat Street, west side, from a point measured 10.9 metres south of the southerly street line of Pembroke Street West to a point measured 18.7 metres south of the southerly street line of Pembroke Street West.
3. Every person who contravenes any section of this by-law is guilty of an offence and on conviction is liable to a fine as provided for in the Provincial Offences Act, as amended.
4. This by-law shall come into full force and effect on the date of final passage hereof.
