

City of Pembroke Community Improvement Plan

Environmental Site Assessment (ESA) Grant

The ESA Grant is intended to promote the undertaking of environmental studies to better understand the type of contamination of potential remediation costs for brownfield sites.

Eligible Costs

1. Confirming and describing contamination at the site
2. Surveying designated substances and hazardous materials at the site
3. Developing a plan to remove, treat, or otherwise manage contamination found on the site

Eligibility Criteria

1. All general program requirements outlined in Sect.6.1 apply
2. Application must be in accordance with Sect.6.12
3. Must submit to the City a Phase 1 ESA that demonstrates that site contamination is likely
4. Application will include: A detailed study work plan; a cost estimate for the study; and a description of the planned redevelopment
5. All environmental studies should be completed by a 'qualified person' as defined by Ontario Regulation 153/04

Financial Details

A grant equivalent to a maximum of 50% of the cost to a maximum of \$3,000 per study; two studies per property/project; and \$6,000 per property/project
