

THE CORPORATION OF THE CITY OF PEMBROKE

BY-LAW 2008 – 39

A BY-LAW TO AMEND BY-LAW 2005-55,
AS AMENDED, BEING A BY-LAW TO REGULATE AND CONTROL
THE PARKING OF VEHICLES IN THE CITY OF PEMBROKE

WHEREAS Section 11(1) of the Municipal Act, 2001, S.O. 2001, c. 25 states that a single-tier municipality may pass by-laws respecting highways, including parking and traffic on highways;

AND WHEREAS the Council of the Corporation of the City of Pembroke deems it expedient to amend By-law 2005-55, being a by-law to regulate and control the parking of vehicles;

NOW THEREFORE THE MUNICIPAL COUNCIL OF THE CORPORATION OF THE CITY OF PEMBROKE ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

1. THAT Schedule “C” – NO PARKING ZONES, of By-law 2005-55 be amended by adding thereto the following:

Deacon Street, both sides, from Mackay Street to River Road.

Cecelia Street, east side, from Bell Street to D’Youville Drive.

Cecelia Street, west side, from Deacon Street to D’Youville Drive.

2. THAT Schedule “I” – NO STOPPING ZONES, of By-law 2005-55 be amended by adding thereto the following:

Mackay Street, both sides, from Bell Street to Laurier Avenue.

3. Every person who contravenes any section of this by-law is guilty of an offence and on conviction is liable to a fine as provided for in the Provincial Offences Act, as amended.

4. This by-law shall come into force and take effect upon the date of the final passing thereof.
