

THE CORPORATION OF THE CITY OF PEMBROKE

BY-LAW NUMBER 2011- 43

A BY-LAW TO AMEND BY-LAW 2005-55,
AS AMENDED, BEING A BY-LAW TO REGULATE AND CONTROL
THE PARKING OF VEHICLES IN THE CITY OF PEMBROKE

WHEREAS Section 11(1) of the Municipal Act, 2001, S.O. 2001, c. 25 states that a single-tier municipality may pass by-laws respecting highways, including parking and traffic on highways;

AND WHEREAS the Council of the Corporation of the City of Pembroke deems it expedient to amend By-law 2005-55, being a by-law to regulate and control the parking of vehicles;

NOW THEREFORE THE MUNICIPAL COUNCIL OF THE CORPORATION OF
THE CITY OF PEMBROKE ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

1. THAT Part I – Interpretation and Definitions – Section 1 – Definitions - of Parking By-law 2005-55 be amended by adding thereto the following:
 27. Recreational Trailer shall mean a unit designed to be towed by a car, van or truck by means of a bumper or hitch frame and used for camping or other recreational activities.
 28. Recreational Vehicle shall mean a motorized wheeled vehicle used for camping or other recreational activities.

2. THAT Part III – PARKING – GENERAL REGULATIONS – of Parking By-law 2005-55 be amended by adding thereto the following:

Section 23 – OVERNIGHT PARKING

- (b) Where signs are erected indicating “Overnight Parking Prohibited”, as set out in Schedule “X”, no person shall stop or park a recreational vehicle and/or a recreational trailer, other than a vehicle or a recreational trailer used for emergency purposes, between the hours of 12:00 midnight and 7:00 a.m. and any vehicle that is so parked may be removed at the owner’s expense when such removal is authorized by a Municipal By-law Enforcement Officer.

3. THAT Part V – PARKING LOTS – Section 2 – PARKING LOT DESIGNATION AND TIME LIMITS – of Parking By-law 2005-55 be amended by adding thereto the following:

(a) Alexander Parking Lot

- (v) No person shall park a recreational vehicle and/or a recreational trailer, other than a vehicle used for emergency purposes, in the Alexander Parking Lot between the hours of 12:00 midnight and 7:00 a.m. and any vehicle that is so parked may be removed at the owner’s expense when such removal is authorized by a Municipal By-law Enforcement Officer.

4. THAT Part V – PARKING LOTS – Section 2 – PARKING LOT DESIGNATION AND TIME LIMITS – of Parking By-law 2005-55 be amended by adding thereto the following:

(iv) Market Square Parking Lot

(v) No person shall park a recreational vehicle or a recreational trailer, other than a vehicle used for emergency purposes, in the Market Square Parking Lot between the hours of 12:00 midnight and 7:00 a.m. and any vehicle that is so parked may be removed at the owner's expense when such removal is authorized by a Municipal By-law Enforcement Officer.

5. THAT Part V – PARKING LOTS – Section 2 – PARKING LOT DESIGNATION AND TIME LIMITS – of Parking By-law 2005-55 be amended by adding thereto the following:

(c) Patterson Parking Lot

(iii) No person shall park a recreational vehicle and/or a recreational trailer, other than a vehicle used for emergency purposes, in the Patterson Parking Lot between the hours of 12:00 midnight and 7:00 a.m. and any vehicle that is so parked may be removed at the owner's expense when such removal is authorized by a Municipal By-law Enforcement Officer.

6. THAT Part V – PARKING LOTS – Section 2 – PARKING LOT DESIGNATION AND TIME LIMITS – of Parking By-law 2005-55 be amended by adding thereto the following:

(d) Barrymore Parking Lot

(iii) No person shall park a recreational vehicle and/or a recreational trailer, other than a vehicle used for emergency purposes, in the Barrymore Parking Lot between the hours of 12:00 midnight and 7:00 a.m. and any vehicle that is so parked may be removed at the owner's expense when such removal is authorized by a Municipal By-law Enforcement Officer.

7. THAT Part V – PARKING LOTS – Section 2 – PARKING LOT DESIGNATION AND TIME LIMITS – of Parking By-law 2005-55 be amended by adding thereto the following:

(e) City Hall Parking Lot

(iii) No person shall park a recreational vehicle and/or a recreational trailer, other than a vehicle used for emergency purposes, in the City Hall Parking Lot between the hours of 12:00 midnight and 7:00 a.m. and any vehicle that is so parked may be removed at the owner's expense when such removal is authorized by a Municipal By-law Enforcement Officer.

8. THAT Part V – PARKING LOTS – Section 2 – PARKING LOT DESIGNATION AND TIME LIMITS - of Parking By-law 2005-55 be amended by adding thereto the following:

(f) Cockburn Parking Lot

- (ii) No person shall park a recreational vehicle and/or a recreational trailer, other than a vehicle used for emergency purposes, in the Cockburn Parking Lot between the hours of 12:00 midnight and 7:00 a.m. and any vehicle that is so parked may be removed at the owner's expense when such removal is authorized by a Municipal By-law Enforcement Officer.

9. THAT Part V – PARKING LOTS – Section 2 – PARKING LOT DESIGNATION AND TIME LIMITS – of Parking By-law 2005-55 be amended by adding thereto the following:

(h) Pembroke Courthouse Parking Lot

- (iii) No person shall park a recreational vehicle and/or a recreational trailer, other than a vehicle used for emergency purposes, in the Pembroke Courthouse Parking Lot between the hours of 12:00 midnight and 7:00 a.m. and any vehicle that is so parked may be removed at the owner's expense when such removal is authorized by a Municipal By-law Enforcement Officer.

10. THAT Part V – PARKING LOTS – Section 2 – PARKING LOT DESIGNATION AND TIME LIMITS – of Parking By-law 2005-55 be amended by adding thereto the following:

(h) Shamrock Parking Lot

- (iii) No person shall park a recreational vehicle and/or a recreational trailer, other than a vehicle used for emergency purposes, in the Shamrock Parking Lot between the hours of 12:00 midnight and 7:00 a.m. and any vehicle that is so parked may be removed at the owner's expense when such removal is authorized by a Municipal By-law Enforcement Officer.

11. THAT Part V – PARKING LOTS – Section 2 – PARKING LOT DESIGNATION AND TIME LIMITS – of Parking By-law 2005-55 be amended by adding thereto the following:

(j) Marina Parking Lot

- (i) The section of land lying north of the C.P.R. tracks and east of Albert Street, shall be established and laid out as a public parking lot.
- (ii) No person shall park a recreational vehicle and/or a recreational trailer, other than a vehicle used for emergency purposes, in the Marina Parking Lot between the hours of 12:00 midnight and 7:00 a.m. and any vehicle that is so parked may be removed at the owner's expense when such removal is authorized by a Municipal By-law Enforcement Officer.

12. THAT Part V – PARKING LOTS – Section 2 – PARKING LOT DESIGNATION AND TIME LIMITS – of Parking By-law 2005-55 be amended by adding thereto the following:

(k) Fred Blackstein Road Parking Lot

- (i) The section of land lying north of the C.P.R. tracks and east of Alexander Street and west of Albert Street, shall be established and laid out as a public parking lot.
- (ii) No person shall park a recreational vehicle and/or a recreational trailer, other than a vehicle used for emergency purposes, in the Fred Blackstein Road Parking Lot between the hours of 12:00 midnight and 7:00 a.m. and any vehicle that is so parked may be removed at the owner's expense when such removal is authorized by a Municipal By-law Enforcement Officer.

13. THAT Part V – PARKING LOTS – Section 2 – PARKING LOT DESIGNATION AND TIME LIMITS – of Parking By-law 2005-55 be amended by adding thereto the following:

(l) Riverside Park Parking Lots

- (i) The section of land lying north of Pembroke Street West, east of Riverside Drive and west of Miramichi Lodge at 725 Pembroke Street West, shall be established and laid out as a public parking lot.
- (ii) No person shall park a recreational vehicle and/or a recreational trailer, other than a vehicle used for emergency purposes, in the Riverside Park Parking Lots between the hours of 12:00 midnight and 7:00 a.m. and any vehicle that is so parked may be removed at the owner's expense when such removal is authorized by a Municipal By-law Enforcement Officer.

14. THAT Part V – PARKING LOTS – Section 2 – PARKING LOT DESIGNATION AND TIME LIMITS – of Parking By-law 2005-55 be amended by adding thereto the following:

(m) Farmers' Market Parking Lot

- (i) The section of land lying north of Pembroke Street West, east of Victoria Street and west of the Muskrat River, shall be established and laid out as a public parking lot.
- (ii) No person shall park a recreational vehicle and/or a recreational trailer, other than a vehicle used for emergency purposes, in the Farmers' Market Parking Lot between the hours of 12:00 midnight and 7:00 a.m. and any vehicle that is so parked may be removed at the owner's expense when such removal is authorized by a Municipal By-law Enforcement Officer.

15. THAT Part V – PARKING LOTS – Section 2 – PARKING LOT DESIGNATION AND TIME LIMITS – of Parking By-law 2005-55 be amended by adding thereto the following:

- (n) Any other City-owned of Pembroke Parking Lot
- (i) No person shall park a recreational vehicle and/or a recreational trailer, other than a vehicle used for emergency purposes, in any other city-owned Pembroke Parking Lots between the hours of 12:00 midnight and 7:00 a.m. and any vehicle that is so parked may be removed at the owner's expense when such removal is authorized by a Municipal By-law Enforcement Officer

16. THAT Schedule "X" – OVERNIGHT PARKING OF RECREATIONAL VEHICLES AND/OR RECREATIONAL TRAILERS PROHIBITED of Parking By-law 2005-55 be amended by adding thereto the following:

SCHEDULE "X" TO BY-LAW 2005-55

Overnight Parking of Recreational Vehicles and/or Recreational Trailers Prohibited (Part III, Section 23(a))

- Alexander Street Parking Lot
- Barrymore Parking Lot
- City Hall Parking Lot
- Cockburn Parking Lot
- Farmers' Market Parking Lot
- Fred Blackstein Road Parking Lot
- Market Square Parking Lot
- Patterson Parking Lot
- Pembroke Courthouse Parking Lot
- Riverside Park Parking Lots
- Shamrock Parking Lot
- All Other City-owned Parking Lots

17. THAT Schedule "T" – FINES AND PENALTIES of Parking By-law 2005-55 be amended by adding thereto the following:


Part III, Section 23(a) - Parked or stopped a recreational vehicle and/or recreational trailer in a City-owned parking lot during prohibited hours (12:00 midnight-7:00 a.m.) -\$50.00

18. Every person who contravenes any section of this by-law is guilty of an offence and on conviction is liable to a fine as provided for in the Provincial Offences Act, as amended.

19. This by-law shall come into force and take effect upon the date of the final passing thereof.


