

THE CORPORATION OF THE CITY OF PEMBROKE

BY-LAW 2011 – 53

A BY-LAW TO AMEND BY-LAW 2005-55,
AS AMENDED, BEING A BY-LAW TO REGULATE AND CONTROL
THE PARKING OF VEHICLES IN THE CITY OF PEMBROKE

WHEREAS Section 10(2) of the Municipal Act, 2001, S.O. 2001, c. 25 states that a single-tier municipality may pass by-laws respecting the governance structure of the municipality and its local boards and services and things that the municipality is authorized to provide under the governance structure;

AND WHEREAS the Council of the Corporation of the City of Pembroke deems it expedient to amend By-law 2005-55, being a by-law to regulate and control the parking of vehicles;

NOW THEREFORE THE MUNICIPAL COUNCIL OF THE CORPORATION OF THE CITY OF PEMBROKE ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

1. THAT Schedule "C" – NO PARKING ZONES, of By-law 2005-55 be amended by deleting therefrom the following:

Isabella Street, south side, from Maiden Lane to the intersection of Hincks Street and Isabella Street.
2. THAT Schedule "C" – NO PARKING ZONES, of By-law 2005-55 be amended by adding thereto the following:

Isabella Street, south side, from Maiden Lane to a point measured west, one hundred and one point one (101.1) metres from the westerly street line of Church Street.


Isabella Street, south side, from Moffat Street to the intersection of Hincks Street and Isabella Street.
3. THAT Schedule "F" – THIRTY MINUTE PARKING ZONES, of By-law 2005-55 be amended by adding thereto the following:

Isabella Street, south side, from Moffat Street to a point measured east, eighty point one (80.1) metres from the easterly street line of Moffat Street.
4. Every person who contravenes any section of this by-law is guilty of an offence and on conviction is liable to a fine as provided for in the Provincial Offences Act, as amended.
5. This by-law shall come into force and take effect upon the date of the final passing thereof.


