

THE CORPORATION OF THE CITY OF PEMBROKE

BY-LAW 2006 – 09

A BY-LAW TO AMEND BY-LAW 2005-55,
AS AMENDED, BEING A BY-LAW TO REGULATE AND CONTROL
THE PARKING OF VEHICLES IN THE CITY OF PEMBROKE

WHEREAS Section 11(1) of the Municipal Act, 2001, S.O. 2001, c. 25 states that a single-tier municipality may pass by-laws respecting highways, including parking and traffic on highways;

AND WHEREAS the Council of the Corporation of the City of Pembroke deems it expedient to amend By-law 2005-55, being a by-law to regulate and control the parking of vehicles;

NOW THEREFORE THE MUNICIPAL COUNCIL OF THE CORPORATION OF THE CITY OF PEMBROKE ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

1. THAT Part IV – METER PARKING ON STREETS – Section 4 – Fines, of By-law 2005-55 be amended by adding thereto the following:
 - (d) No person shall park a vehicle in any metered parking space in such a manner so that the vehicle is outside the space allotted.
2. THAT Part V – PARKING LOTS – Section 1 – General Provisions for all Parking Lots, of By-law 2005-55 be amended by adding thereto the following section:
 - (b) No person shall park a vehicle in any parking lot in such a manner so that the vehicle is outside the space allotted.
3. THAT Part V – PARKING LOTS – Section 3 – Regulations – Metered Parking Lots, of By-law 2005-55 be amended by deleting therefrom the following:
 - (d) No person shall park a vehicle so as to obstruct any other vehicles parked in a public parking lot and any vehicle that is so parked may be removed at the owner's expense when such removal is authorized by a Municipal By-law Enforcement Officer.
 - (e) No person shall park a vehicle in a public parking lot in an ingress or egress area and any vehicle that is so parked may be removed at the owner's expense when such removal is authorized by a Municipal By-law Enforcement Officer.
 - (g) No person shall park a vehicle, other than a vehicle used for emergency purposes, on any public parking lot between the hours of 12:00 midnight and 8:00 a.m. from November 1st to April 30th each year and any vehicle that is so parked may be removed at the owner's expense when such removal is authorized by a Municipal By-law Enforcement Officer.
4. THAT Part V – PARKING LOTS – Section 3 – Regulations – Metered Parking Lots, of By-law 2005-55 be further amended by adding thereto the following:
 - (d) No person shall park a vehicle so as to obstruct any other vehicles parked in a metered parking lot and any vehicle that is so parked may be removed at the owner's expense when such removal is authorized by a Municipal By-law Enforcement Officer

- (e) No person shall park a vehicle in a metered parking lot in an ingress or egress area and any vehicle that is so parked may be removed at the owner's expense when such removal is authorized by a Municipal By-law Enforcement Officer.
 - (g) No person shall park a vehicle, other than a vehicle used for emergency purposes, on any metered parking lot between the hours of 12:00 midnight and 8:00 a.m. from November 1st to April 30th each year and any vehicle that is so parked may be removed at the owner's expense when such removal is authorized by a Municipal By-law Enforcement Officer.
5. THAT Part V – PARKING LOTS – Section 5 – Regulations – Permit Parking Lots, of By-law 2005-55 be amended by deleting therefrom the following:
- (c) No person shall park a vehicle in a public parking lot in an ingress or egress area and any vehicle that is so parked may be removed at the owner's expense when such removal is authorized by a Municipal By-law Enforcement Officer.
 - (d) No person shall park a vehicle, other than a vehicle used for emergency purposes, on any public permit parking lot between the hours of 12:00 midnight and 8:00 a.m. from November 1st to April 30th each year and any vehicle that is so parked may be removed at the owner's expense when such removal is authorized by a Municipal By-law Enforcement Officer.
6. THAT Part V – PARKING LOTS – Section 5 – Regulations – Permit Parking Lots, of By-law 2005-55 be further amended by adding thereto the following:
- (c) No person shall park a vehicle in a permit parking lot in an ingress or egress area and any vehicle that is so parked may be removed at the owner's expense when such removal is authorized by a Municipal By-law Enforcement Officer.
 - (d) No person shall park a vehicle, other than a vehicle used for emergency purposes, on any permit parking lot between the hours of 12:00 midnight and 8:00 a.m. from November 1st to April 30th each year and any vehicle that is so parked may be removed at the owner's expense when such removal is authorized by a Municipal By-law Enforcement Officer.
7. THAT Schedule “B” – LOADING ZONES, of By-law 2005-55 be amended by adding thereto the following:
- Pembroke Street West, south side, from a point measured 68.0 metres east of the easterly street line of Church Street to a point measured 74.1 metres east of the easterly street line of Church Street.
8. THAT Schedule “C” – NO PARKING ZONES, of By-law 2005-55 be amended by deleting therefrom the following:
- Cecelia Street, west side, from Pembroke Street East northerly to Nelson Street.

- 9. THAT Schedule “C” – NO PARKING ZONES, of By-law 2005-55 be further amended by adding thereto the following:

Cecelia Street, east side, from Pembroke Street East northerly to Nelson Street.

- 10. THAT Schedule “D” – TEN MINUTE PARKING ZONES, of By-law 2005-55 be amended by adding thereto the following:

Prince Street, east side, from a point measured 15.5 metres south of the southerly street line of Lake Street, to a point measured 21.6 metres south of the southerly street line of Lake Street.

- 11. THAT Schedule “I” – NO STOPPING ZONES, of By-law 2005-55 be amended by adding thereto the following:

Agnes Street, west side, from the north street line of Pembroke Street West northerly 48.0 metres to a point measured 54.1 metres north of the northerly street line of Pembroke Street West.

Church Street, west side, from the south street line of Pembroke Street West southerly 13.9 metres to a point measured 20.0 metres south of the southerly street line of Pembroke Street West. This space is to be used for “Police Parking Only”.

- 12. Every person who contravenes any section of this by-law is guilty of an offence and on conviction is liable to a fine as provided for in the Provincial Offences Act, as amended.
- 13. This by-law shall come into force and take effect upon the date of the final passing thereof.
