

THE CORPORATION OF THE CITY OF PEMBROKE

BY-LAW 2006 – 60

A BY-LAW TO AMEND BY-LAW 2005-55,
AS AMENDED, BEING A BY-LAW TO REGULATE AND CONTROL
THE PARKING OF VEHICLES IN THE CITY OF PEMBROKE

WHEREAS Section 11(1) of the Municipal Act, 2001, S.O. 2001, c. 25 states that a single-tier municipality may pass by-laws respecting highways, including parking and traffic on highways;

AND WHEREAS the Council of the Corporation of the City of Pembroke deems it expedient to amend By-law 2005-55, being a by-law to regulate and control the parking of vehicles;

NOW THEREFORE THE MUNICIPAL COUNCIL OF THE CORPORATION OF THE CITY OF PEMBROKE ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

1. THAT Schedule “J” – NO STOPPING ZONES – TIME RESTRICTED – Section 1, of By-law 2005-55 be amended by deleting therefrom the following:

Peter Street, east side, from Pembroke Street East to Supple Street.

2. THAT Schedule “J” – NO STOPPING ZONES – TIME RESTRICTED – Section 1, of By-law 2005-55 be amended by adding thereto the following:

No Stopping Zone, Monday to Friday between 0900 hrs and 1800 hrs, at the following locations:

(i) Peter Street, east side from Pembroke Street East to Supple Street.

(ii) Supple Street, north and south sides, from Peter Street to Cecelia Street.

3. THAT Schedule “J” – NO STOPPING ZONES – TIME RESTRICTED – Section 2, of By-law 2005-55 be amended by deleting therefrom the following:

William Street, west side, from Supple Street to Esther Street.

4. THAT Schedule “Q” – POSTED FIRE ROUTES, Section 1, of By-law 2005-55 be amended by adding thereto the following:

Marguerite Centre from Mackay Street entrance to Deacon Street entrance. (700 Mackay Street).

5. Every person who contravenes any section of this by-law is guilty of an offence and on conviction is liable to a fine as provided for in the Provincial Offences Act, as amended.

6. This by-law shall come into force and take effect upon the date of the final passing thereof.
