For Immediate Release – May 27, 2019

Team Rubicon Canada is operating in the City of Pembroke at the invitation of the municipal authorities to assist with recovery planning. Over the next few weeks, our Rapid Damage Assessment teams will be working in areas identified by municipal planners as those that have been highly impacted by the recent floods. Homeowners—of both primary and seasonal residences—who have been impacted are encouraged to self-identify through the Request for Assistance form at the link below. These requests will be cataloged and the information collected through them will give municipal planners a better understanding of the impacts throughout the area, which will aid in recovery planning.
