Pembroke marina will soon open to the public

As construction finishes up, the Pembroke marina will soon be fully open to the public for the 2020 boating season.

As of Friday, June 5 at 12 p.m., the marina's service dock will be open and operational with its gas service and pump-outs. The boat launch, which has been open already free of charge, will return to its regular service with fees of \$6.99 + HST for a daily launch or \$70.40 + HST for a seasonal launch. Ice is also available. The marina's hours of operation will be Monday-Friday 12-8 p.m. and Saturday-Sunday 10 a.m.-6 p.m.

Federally contracted construction work at the marina has delayed boaters with slips to access them, but work is nearing substantial completion. City staff have been working hard alongside the private contractor to get the marina prepared for boaters, and, although not confirmed, it is hopeful the ramps will be installed by mid-next week and all docks and slips would be accessible to authorized slip holders at that time. Confirmation of this and water and electrical services is still to come, and the City will provide continued updates as information is received.

Public health measures will be in place for the protection of staff and the boating public. The City encourages anyone seeking services at the marina to respect physical distancing and/or wear a mask for the protection of all.
