Riverside Park opening June 17

Riverside Park campground will be open to the public starting Wednesday, June 17.

At this point, camping will only be open for self-contained units. Campers must follow social gathering size restrictions as given by the Province, and maintain two meter physical distancing with people from outside their household when outside of their campsites.

Staff will be available 8 a.m.-10 p.m. Sunday to Thursday and 8 a.m. to midnight Friday-Saturday. The fieldhouse and beach house bathrooms will be open, but shower and laundry facilities will remain closed at this time. Extra sanitation measures are being put in place by staff to ensure the safety of everyone.

Camping costs for serviced sites are \$34+HST per night, or \$210+HST per week for a maximum of two weeks. Reservations are not available until June 17. To make a reservation, please contact the park directly at 613-735-6821 ext. 1504.

For other park amenities, mini golf will be open during daylight. The playground and beach will remain closed until further notice. However, the splash pads at both Riverside and Rotary Park will open as of June 17 as well.
