### **City of Pembroke offices reopen to the public**

Members of the public are encouraged to continue contacting City of Pembroke staff ahead of time before reaching out in person as Parks & Recreation Department and Operations Department offices reopen to the public June 15, joining City Hall which opened June 8.

Starting today, these offices are open again for walk-in traffic, but things are different from before the outbreak of the COVID-19 pandemic. All offices have posted entry guidelines including passing a health screening self-assessment, maximum occupancy and the use of hand sanitizer. If people have to wait to get into the building, they must practise physical distancing.

To help keep people safe and for expedient service, the City encourages people to continue to reach out to staff via their emails or by phone and either be helped that way or make an appointment to see staff.

“We are happy to welcome the public back to our offices,” says Mayor Mike LeMay. “We remind people to be patient as they follow the new guidelines which are for the health and safety of everyone.”
