### **Christie Street Bridge Between McGee Street and Everett Street**

Effective October 9, 2020 at 9:00 a.m. and continuing until October 30, 2020 3:30 p.m., Christie Street Bridge, between McGee Street and Everett Street, will be temporarily reduced to one lane to facilitate a water main repair.

Traffic will be controlled by the installation of temporary traffic lights. At times flag persons will be directing traffic. Delays can be expected. The travelling public is encouraged to use alternate routes.

The City of Pembroke asks that drivers respect the posted construction signage at all times.

You are also reminded that the businesses within the construction and detour zones remain open for business and the many business owners would be happy to serve you.
