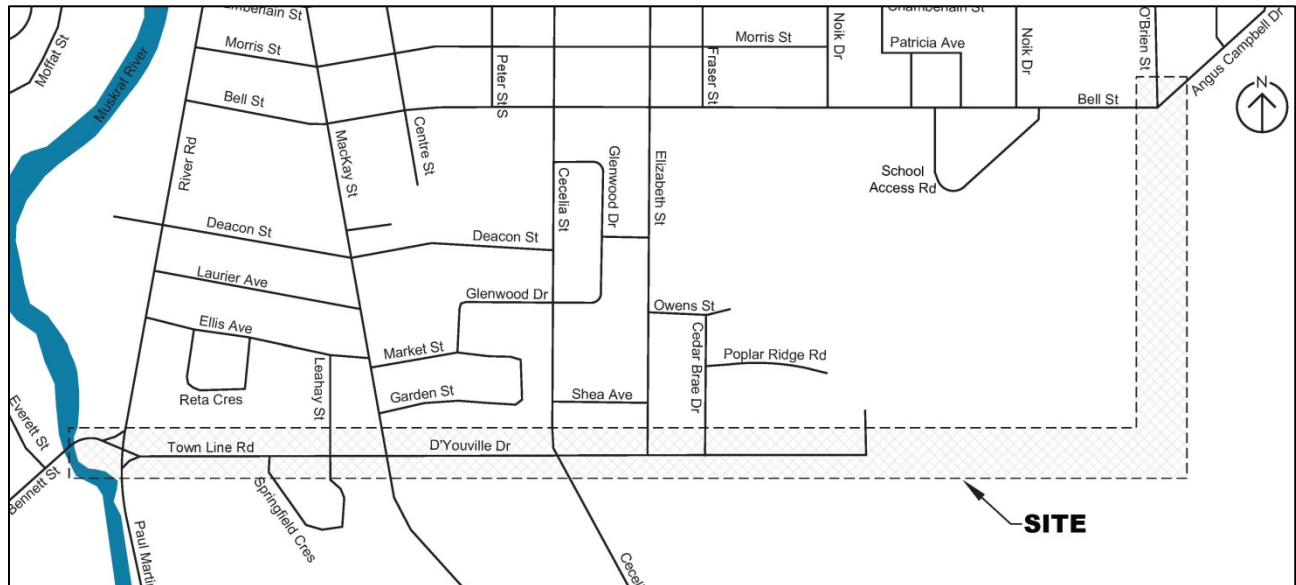




**City of Pembroke – Notice of Project**  
**Municipal Class Environmental Assessment**  
**Townline Lift Station – Forcemain Upgrades**

The City of Pembroke has retained Ainley Group to complete detail design activities and to undertake the Municipal Class Environmental Assessment (MCEA) process for forcemain upgrades. The forcemain upgrades are proposed to extend within the right-of-way (ROW) along Townline Road and D’Youville Drive, and within a property easement between D’Youville Drive and Bell Street. The location is shown on the key map below.

The new forcemain will be installed in parallel with the existing forcemain along Townline Road and D’Youville Drive to facilitate repairs and maintenance when required.



The project is following a pre-approved planning process for a Schedule ‘A+’ undertaking in accordance with the Municipal Class Environmental Assessment document (MCEA), which applies to municipal infrastructure projects including roads, bridges, water, and wastewater projects. Schedule ‘A+’ projects are pre-approved under the MCEA and may proceed to construction, pending funding and agency approvals.

Construction is currently scheduled for 2021-2023, pending funding and agency approvals.
