City of Pembroke closes outdoor recreational amenities

In accordance with today's provincial announcement strengthening the stay-at-home order, the City of Pembroke will be altering its operations to ensure the continued safety of residents.

Effective on Saturday, April 17, 2021 at 12:01 a.m., the Rapids Skate Park, all playgrounds and other outdoor recreational amenities in the City will be closed. This includes tennis courts, basketball courts and soccer fields. Walking trails and open parks within the City will remain open. Physical distance must be maintained with those outside your household when visiting areas such as the Kiwanis Walkway at the waterfront. Please continue to follow all public health guidelines of the Renfrew County and District Health Unit.
