## **Council Briefs, May 18, 2021**

The following actions were taken at the Committee and Council meetings of Tuesday, May 18, 2021:

### **Combined Committee**

#### **Canadian Red Cross Request**

Committee approved the partnership between the City of Pembroke and Canadian Red Cross in the Inclusive Resilience: Reducing Disaster Risk for Canadians pilot project.

#### **Parking Meter Report**

Committee approved an extension of the free two-hour parking at all downtown meters until the end of the year (December 31, 2021) with the loss of parking meter revenue to be funded from the COVID Safe Restart Funds.

Combined Committee denied the request from the Pembroke Public Library for permanent two-hour free parking at the five meters in front of the library on Victoria Street.

#### **Fire Hydrant Relocation Request – 699 Elgin Street**

Committee denied the request for the fire hydrant relocation at 699 Elgin Street at City cost.

#### **NDMP Intake 4 – Moffat Street Slope Stability**

Committee approved the extension of works related to NDMP Intake 4 for the Moffat Street Slope Stability project.

#### **NDMP Intake 6 – City Wide Flood Risk Assessment & Storm Outlet Review**

Committee approved the use of funds from the Moffat Street – Storm Sewer Outfall #27 project for the City's contribution to the NDMP – Intake 6: City Wide Flood Risk Assessment and Storm Outlet Review project.

#### **Supply and Delivery of One (1) Single Axle Cab and Chassis with Combination Dump Body/Spreader Unit with Hydraulic Plow and Wing – Request for Proposal P-21-04**

Committee approved the award of the supply and delivery of one single axle cab and chassis with combination dump body/spreader unit with hydraulic plow and wing, Request for Proposal No. P-21-04 to Bill Clouthier & Sons Ltd. (Valley Truck & Spring Service) in the amount of \$232,900.00 plus HST.
