Responsibilities

Reporting to and under the direction of the Manager – Planning, Building and By-law Enforcement, to be responsible for enforcing the by-laws implemented throughout the City of Pembroke, including the Parking By-Law. Patrol by foot and by car to monitor for by-law parking infractions throughout the City and ticket as necessary.

Duties

- 1. Take field note information and complete diary on a daily basis.
- 2. Respond to public inquiries in a courteous manner, with tact and diplomacy within the scope of knowledge.
- Must possess and exercise a high degree of accuracy in day-to-day activities

- 6. Assist with provision of evidence and testimony at court, as required.
- 7. Must be able to perform other related duties as assigned.

Hours of Work:
