Parking

Street parking

Most streets throughout Pembroke have free parking available. There is a three-hour max on parking on municipal streets.

Metered spots

Shopping or eating in our downtown? There are many metered spots (\$0.25/half hour) available. These can be paid with change or digitally on the Honk Mobile app. Check downtownpembroke.ca for maps and a guide to find free spots.

Parking lots

Visiting one of our parks, exploring the Waterfront, or checking out a hockey game or concert? Our parks and facilities (including the pool and rinks) have free parking for those visiting the park or using the facility. Many of these lots are two-hour or three-hour max.

Accessible permit holders

Pembroke has ample parking space to accommodate those requiring accessible parking spaces. All existing signage and meter fees do apply.

Charging

Pembroke has several options for those with electric vehicles to plug in and charge. There is a level 3 charger at Scotiabank (81 Pembroke St. W.) and at the Pembroke Regional Hospital, as well as level 2 chargers at City Hall, the Pembroke Memorial Centre, the Pembroke and Area Community Centre (Pem Ice II), Pembroke Waterfront Park and Pembroke Regional Hospital.
