Under the direction of the Manager of Operations you will perform a variety of asset management related duties to assist in long term planning and work prioritization activities for municipal assets.

Responsibilities

1. Assist with asset management related measures (lifecycle costs, level of service, depreciation, etc) to identify emerging issues and trends.
2. Assist in the collection and entering of data into the City's GIS.
3. Provide support for the ongoing management of operational and capital improvements of real property and infrastructure.
4. Assist in identifying and implementing capital improvement projects.
5. Assist in the implementation of minor capital projects specific to sections.
6. Assist in the preparation, organization and maintenance of engineering field and office data, reports and systems.
7. Assist in preparation of necessary reports for management, Council and senior government.
8. Assist in the development of funding applications, requests for proposals and tenders for the various works of the Corporation.
9. Provide assistance to the Department Manager as may be required.
