



A-BOARD SIGNS

- a. No application shall be required for a **single** A-Board sign on **private** property.
- b. A permit shall be required for each A-Board sign per business to be erected on City property and shall be located clear of pedestrian or vehicular traffic and subject to approval.
- c. A-Board signs shall be a maximum of 4 ft. (1.22 m) high and 2.5 ft. (0.76 m) wide, and have a maximum area of 10 ft² (0.93 m²). A-Board signs shall not reduce the sidewalk clear passage to less than 5 ft. (1.52 m) or encroach on any street or laneway.
- d. A-Board signs shall be removed at the close of business hours and shall be removed by the owners during snow removal operations or severe wind and weather conditions.
- e. A-Board signs shall not have any projections from the sides or bottom beyond the maximum parameters set out above in item “c” nor shall any part of the sign be designed so as to create a hazard to pedestrians. The signs shall be of professional appearance and aesthetically pleasing.
- f. A plan of the sign, its location, a copy of the owner’s liability insurance (minimum \$1,000,000.00) and a signed agreement to indemnify the City of Pembroke against any liabilities as a result of the placing of the sign shall be submitted with each application.
- g. A minimum fee of \$50.00 shall accompany the application. The permit shall be renewed when the business changes ownership.
